Studio's Editors Winding Up Work on '49 Shooting

Nineteen features currently being edited will give Columbia Pictures virtually a clean slate when the new year's production schedule gets under way next month. Only one more feature, the Glenn Ford starrer, "One Way Out," is yet to begin production before Jan. 1.

Humphrey Bogart's Santana production, "Behind This Mask," which completed camera work last week, is being edited by Viola Lawrence. The Technicolor musical, "The Petty Girl," starring Robert Cummings and Joan Caulfield, is being assembled by Al Clark. Charles Nelson is editing the Ray Milland-Rosalind Russell comedy, "A Woman of Distinction," and the William Bendix comedy, "Kill the Umpire."

"Beauty on Parade," featuring Robert Hutton, Ruth Warrick and Lela Albert, is being cut by Aaron St. John. The current "Customs Agent," featuring William Eythe and Marjorie Reynolds. James Sweeney has "Military Academy," featuring Stanley Clements, Myron Walton, Gene Collins and Leon Tyler, and the currently shooting "State Penitentiary," starring Warner Baxter.
