

Deanna's Latest Film Set For Opening At Ohio Friday

"Lady On A Train," Deanna Durbin's newest picture, comes to the Ohio theatre Friday, an announcement which film fans have been hoping for and expecting a long time.

The film, a comedy-mystery, is based on an original story by Leslie Charteris, creator of the popular "Saint" series and is a complete departure for Deanna and another step in giving the public varied performances by the star.

In the new film, Deanna portrays an amateur sleuth and does a simply superb job of it. An avid reader of mystery stories, she sees a murder committed as she is arriving in New York on a train. She sees the victim, but does not see the assailant. However, she is determined to run down the murderer, even tho the victim, a wealthy man, is reported to have died an accidental death.

Only one day left to see the two hit pictures, "Pin Up Girl" with Betty Grable and Martha Raye and "Buffalo Bill" with Joel McCrea and Maureen O'Hara. Both pictures, returned to Lima thru popular request, received top billing on any marquee in the country not so long ago, and now, they've been brought to Lima citizens all on one bill. Coming Friday to the Quilna theatre are two more films which were, in no uncertain words, demanded by the public, "The Adventures of Tom Sawyer," in technicolor, and "Prisoner of Zenda," a Ronald Colman-Douglas Fairbanks, Jr. thriller of not so many seasons back.

Boris Karloff does well in his role as a Greek general in "Isle of the Dead" not showing at the Sigma theatre. The story of this film tells of this general who returns to a deserted, or supposedly deserted, island where he might mourn the death of his wife, in peace. Overcome with the plague, he slowly goes mad to add to all the other confusion which arises. Sharing the billing is "Crashing Thru" with Renfrew of the Northwest Mounted police.
