

'Where Do We Go From Here?' Is Year's No. 1 Laugh Show

Local moviegoers are in for the screen treat of the year when they see "Where Do We Go From Here?" the musical like nothing on earth with a story that's out of this world, opening Friday at the Quilna Theatre.

The hilarious, melody-packed film which stars Fred MacMurray, Joan Leslie and June Haver, tells of the gloriously zany adventures of Fred MacMurray on a cross-century girl hunt chasing two 1945 cuties from a Bronx USO canteen thru Valley Forge to the discovery of America by Columbus in 1492, and then some.

One of the highlights of the film, "Back to Bataan" opening at the Ohio theatre is the factual reenactment of the daring raid by American Rangers and Filipino guerrillas on the Cabanatuan prison camp in Luzon which freed 513 Allied prisoners. John Wayne has the leading role with Anthony Quinn, Beulah Bondi, Fely Franquelli and Leonard Strong in the supporting cast.

A mystery tribe of women is the principal feature of "Tarzan and the Amazons," Johnny Weissmuller's newest starring vehicle based on the world-famous Edgar Rice Burroughs stories. He brings a new leading lady to the series in the person of Brenda Joyce, and again presents young Johnny Sheffield as his son, Boy. The film will open Saturday at the Sigma theatre.

Newest screen find in Hollywood is Yvonne De Carlo who has the leading role in "Salome, Where She Danced" currently playing at the State theatre. She is starred with David Bruce and Rod Cameron in this story of how a girl discovered the plans for the Prussian invasion of Austria and how she escaped.

Two films which are certain to suit western fans to a "T" will open for one day only at the Lyric theatre Saturday. They are "Sign of the Wolf" and "Tonto Basin Outlaw" and should be put on the "must see" list.

NO IMPROVEMENT SEEN IN POTATO SUPPLY

Local Ohioans Squeeze U. S. Pincers On Japanese

Two Ohioans, with a veteran American division in the Cebu-Boloh-Negros area of the Philippines, have learned the hard way what newspapers mean when they say that "mopping up is in progress."

The two soldiers, Pvt. Alphonse W. Koester, of Ft. Jennings Route 2, and Pvt. Victorinus F. Merscham, of Ft. Jennings Route 1, have been in the thick of the fighting in that area in the Philippines where American doughboys, supported by Filipino guerrilla forces, have killed nearly 10,000 Japanese.

Pvt. Merscham was among a group of soldiers who had been awarded the Combat Infantryman's Badge, a United Press dispatch said.

The American Division, with which many Ohioans are serving, is the only division in the Army not designated by number. Overseas 3 1/2 years, it has fought alongside Ohio's 37th Division at Bougainville, and also has seen action at Guadalcanal, Leyte, Samar, Cebu, Boloh, Negros and Mindanao.

SPICER STRIKE

Is Continuing

TOLEDO, July 6 — (AP) — A work stoppage by 6,000 production and office employees of the Spicer Manufacturing Co., producer of jeep parts, continued today with no indication of early settlement.

The walkout began among office workers following the discharge of woman employee, John Bolman, chairman of the office workers division of the CIO-United Automobile Workers, said production employees "while not on strike, have joined our picket line in sympathy."

Tom Burke, vice president of UAW Local 12 of which the production employees are members, described the stoppage as a "wildcat" strike.

DAMAGE SUIT FILED CLEVELAND, July 6 — (AP) — On file in common pleas court today was a \$10,000 damage suit, entered by a man who alleged he was beaten because he asked for cigarettes. The suit was entered by Charles H. Burrows against Norman Isaac, owner of a cafe and howling alley in Southwest Cleveland, where the petition says the alleged assault took place June 15.
